File Folders

INSTRUCTIONS

1. You will need two (2) pieces of 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper (DSP) and one (1) file folder. The DSP can be the same or two coordinating pieces.
2. Measure the width of your file folder and trim one piece of DSP to the same width. NOTE: If using DSP with a directional pattern be sure you trim the correct side.
3. Line one edge of the DSP with the front tab of the file folder and fold remaining piece to the backside of the folder.
4. Measure the height of the back of the file folder starting 1/2" below the folded flap to the top edge of the back tab. Trim the second piece of DSP by this measurement and trim the appropriate edge to make the piece the same width as the front piece of DSP.
5. Apply glue to the back of the file folder and attach the shorter piece of DSP to the back being sure to line the DSP with the top tab and the side edges.
6. Apply glue to the front of the file folder and to the back flap of the DSP and attach to file folder lining up edges.
7. Trim along the top edges of the file folder with Paper Snips.
